National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) 2017

Messages from the Deputies

NAPLAN 9 - 11 May 2017

NAPLAN tests provide parents and schools with an understanding of how individual students are performing at the time of the tests and they also provide schools, states and territories with information about how education programs are working and what areas need to be prioritised for improvement. These tests are one aspect of a school's assessment and reporting process and do not replace the extensive ongoing assessments made by teachers about each student's performance.

NAPLAN assesses literacy and numeracy skills that students have already been learning through the school curriculum. Teachers will ensure students are familiar with the test formats and will provide appropriate support and guidance. The best way you can help your child prepare for NAPLAN is to reassure your child that NAPLAN tests are just one part of their school program, and urge them to simply do the best they can on the day.

A NAPLAN report will be issued later in the year. The same report format is used for every student in Australia. Individual student performance will be shown on a national achievement scale for each test and the performance of individual students can be compared to the average performance of all students in Australia.

Road Safety

We would ask everyone to always been mindful of road safety rules. A number of our students either ride or walk to school and their safety is of utmost importance.

Children need reminders about the road rules; how to cross roads safely, wearing of safety equipment, keeping to the left on footpaths etc. Please remind your children that they should wear an approved helmet if riding a bike or scooter to school.

If you're travelling on a wheeled recreational device or wheeled toy **you must not**:

- travel on a road with a centre line or median strip, or a 1-way road with more than 1 marked lane
- travel on a road with a speed limit greater than 50km/h
- travel on a road at night—but you may cross a road while riding your wheeled recreational device by the shortest route. If you need to ride at night, you can ride your wheeled recreational device on a footpath
- travel alongside more than 1 other person or vehicle travelling on a road in the same direction, unless you are overtaking
- cause a traffic hazard by moving into the path of a driver, or unreasonably obstruct the path of any other road user.

Cybersafety

Whilst we understand that iPads in the iPad classes are commonly used both at home and school by different family members, please be aware services like Snapchat, Messenger and Tinder should be made unavailable during the hours of 9:00am to 3:00pm or password protected. The availability of Snapchat has been detected on iPads at school which contravenes the iPad Student Participation Agreement. A reminder of the rules when using any device at school:

Safety and Security

- 1. Whilst at school, I will only connect my iPad to Education Queensland's Managed Internet Service. I am not permitted to access 3G/4G Internet at school.
- 2. Whilst at school, I will **only go to websites at school** that support my learning activities.
- 3. I will only use my school email account for mail related to my learning.
- 4. I will be cybersafe and cybersmart when using the internet.
- 5. I will demonstrate **etiquette** when using my iPad and other equipment with regard to other people.
- 6. I will use my iPad lawfully and in accordance with the school guidelines regarding **ethical use** of equipment, technology, use of legal software, use of Internet and the protection of personal data.
- 7. For security reasons, I am **not to share account names and passwords** with anyone unless requested by Gumdale State School staff when servicing the iPad.
- 8. I am responsible for the security and use of my iPad whilst at Gumdale State School.

I understand if the above conditions are not followed, I may lose my privilege to use my iPad at Gumdale State School for such time, determined by the school.

Sound Waves

Sound Waves is based on the **phonemic approach** which is recognised as one of the **most effective** ways to teach **spelling and reading** skills. It uses a sound-to-letter strategy. By identifying the basic units of sound in our language (**phonemes**) students explore the letter or letter combinations (**graphemes**) that represent these sounds and how they can be put together to form written words.

The school has access to use **Sound Waves online**. This means each child will have an access code to practise spelling at home. They can do this by visiting www.soundwaveskids.com.au and entering their year level code (found on the back of Year Level Curriculum Newsletters or classroom teacher). The access includes speech pathologist recordings, segmenting tools for identifying sounds and many great interactive spelling games.

Managing your reputation

When you send something digitally, either via your mobile phone or over the internet, you lose control over who sees it and what they do with it. You may never be able to permanently delete the image or text, so it is important that before you send something, think about what you are sending and where it might end up.

Do you know who you are sending it to?

You might be tricked into thinking you are communicating with a friend, but can you ever be sure that it is only them holding the phone or looking at the screen?

Do you know what they will do with it?

Even if you are sure who is on the other end, can you really trust them? If your relationship turns sour, can you be sure that they won't use that text or image against you?

Do you want it to be around forever?

Once you have shared something in a digital format, it can easily be distributed to others and posted on the internet. Distribution might start with just your school, but it can quickly spread to your community and beyond. Once you put something on the internet, it can never be permanently deleted. Think about these things before you ever share something digitally.

So what can you do about it?

Type your name into a search engine and see what's out there about you. Regularly search for your name, username, email address and phone number in online search engines such as Google, Bing or Yahoo! You can also use meta search engines such as www.pipl.com for a deeper search. If you don't like what is out there, take ownership and have it removed or balance it with positive content.

Your online reputation is your responsibility so take control of what your digital shadow is saying about you!

Term 2 – Working together, safely and Respectful (Getting Along)


Term 3 - Great Learner (Resilience and Confidence)
