

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017 Gumdale State School will receive **\$281 000***

This funding will be used to


- Attain 100% of students in Year 3 at or above National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Reading and Numeracy in 2016.
- Maintain 100% of students in Year 5 achieving at or above National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Reading in 2016 and increase the number of students in Year 5 Numeracy achieving at or above National Minimum Standard to 100%.
- Maintain the percentage of Year 3 students in upper 2 bands for NAPLAN Reading at 65% in 2016 and increase the number of Year 5 students in the U2B for Reading from 47% to 55%.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students in upper 2 bands for NAPLAN Numeracy from 50% to 60% in 2016 and increase the number of Year 5 students in the U2B for Numeracy from 28% to 35%
- Develop a plan to support students who do not achieve expectations.
- Improve teacher capability through focused professional development and collegial feedback models to improve student outcomes.
- Support the implementation of quality Literacy and Numeracy programs.

Our initiatives include

- Curriculum, Teaching and Learning team consisting of: Deputy Principal, HoC (Student Achievement), Master Teacher, Support Teacher Aides to maximise learning outcomes for students.
- Whole school improvement of teaching practice by focusing on our school's core priorities: Explicit Instruction, Goal Setting, Feedback, Differentiation to meet Improved Literacy and Numeracy outcomes.
- Development of quality Literacy and Numeracy programs including intervention, extension, before clinics, and STEM programs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing a Head of Curriculum (Student Achievement) to work with teachers and students to improve learning outcomes in Literacy and Numeracy	\$120 000
• Funding 3 x Teacher Aides to work with the Curriculum, Teaching and Learning team to provide extension and intervention in Literacy and Numeracy	\$140 000
• Releasing Prep teachers to implement Early Start Assessment	\$ 3 000
• Offering release time for teachers to engage in collegial conversations and planning.	\$ 18 000
