**Under this agreement for 2019
Gumdale State School will receive**

\$281,790*

This funding will be used to

- 100% of Prep students achieving a minimum PM Level 5 by the end of the year.
- 60% of students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science.
- 90% of students achieving a 'C' or higher in English, Mathematics and Science.
- Attain 100% of students in Year 3 and 5 at or above National Minimum Standard in all NAPLAN Reading and Writing.
- Attain the following literacy upper 2 band results:

	Year 3	Year 5
Reading	70%	55%
Writing	70%	40%

Our initiatives include

- Coach teachers in data collection, analysis and utilisation to **improve student literacy outcomes**.
- Continue to embed the culture, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback utilising a whole school approach to the teaching of **reading and writing** including refinement of pedagogical models, reading and comprehension strategies.
- Resource and implement professional development, coaching and collegial dialogue to improve literacy **differentiation** practices.
- Utilise Early Start materials across Prep and Year 1 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track student improvement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Funding 1 x **Pedagogical Coach** (Reading and Writing) to engage in targeted coaching, professional development and collegial conversations with teachers. (\$129 000).
- Funding 3 x 0.5 **Curriculum, Teaching and Learning Teachers** to work with teachers and students to improve literacy learning outcomes. (\$112 000).
- Funding **Teacher Aide** to support classroom literacy extension and intervention (\$40 000).
