## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard from 97.6% in 2013 Year 3 reading to 99% in 2015 Year 5 reading
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands of NAPLAN Reading from 52.4% in year 3 2015 to 60% in year 5 2017
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 72% in Year Prep (2014) to 80% in Year 1 (2015)
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 72.2% in Year 1 (2014) to 83% in Year 2 (2015)
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 81.5% in Year 2 (2014) to 90% in Year 3 (2015)

## Our strategy will be to

- Develop collaborative data inquiry processes (to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and differentiate better)
- Facilitate action learning/action research to identify and verify the effectiveness of strategies currently in use through USQ Masters of Professional Studies Program
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support and extension to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Develop teacher capability to design curriculum-aligned monitoring and assessment tasks (for short-term data cycles) through the development of cohort teacher leaders
- Build teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to determine the different year-level curriculum some students require and to develop and successfully implement ambitious but achievable individual curriculum plans
- Establish a professional learning community of school leaders and teachers to share and evaluate strategies and their impact
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning
